Dismantling the Brocade 300



Remove:

- 1. The two combination power supply/fan units.
- 2. The screws holding the cover in place to access the motherboard/PCBA.

Dismantling the Brocade 300 Motherboard (PCBA)



WEEE Items for Removal

- 1. Lithium battery board location: BAT1 (WEEE Annex II component).
- 2. Compact flash board location: CF MOD1. (Can be resold.)
- 3. ASIC board location: U22 Remove the heat sink covering the ASIC. Destroy the ASIC.

The components that contain Brominated Flame Retardants are on the board in the following locations:

Y1, L3, L2, L1, U54, D3, D6, D7, D1, D4, U51, U14, U26, U13, U56, D5, U31, U57, U16, U34, U52, U12, U20, U36, U37, U38, U8, U1, U60, U61, U22, U32, U33, Q8, Q13, Q24, U3, U15, U17, Q9, Q11, Q32, Q10, Q12, Q31, Q2, Q6, Q33, Q26, Q27, Q28, Q29, J13

For all other items, follow your normal recycling process.
