CHI operates 87 hospitals, two community health organizations, two nursing colleges, home health agencies, and long-term care, assisted living and residential facilities in 17 states. In 2013, CHI provided nearly \$762 million in charity care.

CHALLENGE

CHI needed to enhance project management and improve enterprise visibility. Because CHI project managers use Microsoft Project, that software had to be integrated with CA Project & Portfolio Management, which CHI already used for time tracking.

Providing millions with healthcare

The nation's third-largest Catholic health care system, CHI operates 87 acute-care hospitals, two community health service organizations, two accredited nursing colleges, home health agencies, and several other sites including long-term care, assisted living and residential facilities in 17 states. For the 2013 fiscal year, CHI provided nearly \$762 million in charity care and community benefit and had operating revenues of approximately \$10.7 billion.

Challenge

More integrated and effective IT project management with enterprise visibility

CHI's enterprise program management office (EPMO) was established during CHI's "One IT" initiative. The One IT mission was to integrate CHI's disparate IT organizations, which were at the time managed by its various market-based organizations, under one corporate shared services model responsible for enterprise-wide projects including clinical applications, facilities infrastructure, and other IT projects.

At that time, CHI used CA Project & Portfolio Management to track project time, giving resource managers visibility into what their teams were working on and providing resource and demand management in support of program and portfolio management. With the passage of the HITECH Act to improve health care delivery and patient care through investments in health IT, along with other organizational and enterprise factors, CHI needed to increase its ability to manage and control projects across the organization. The project executive steering committee set a goal to improve enterprise visibility into its portfolio, and would do so by taking advantage of CA Project & Portfolio Management's full functionality.

Because CHI's project managers use Microsoft Project, it was important for CHI to bring that software into the team's toolbox by integrating it with CA Project & Portfolio Management to continue bringing in the actuals and tracking resources.

Solution

Consulting on integration, best practices and training

CHI Portfolio Manager Angela Strous says, “Integration and user-adoption issues were inhibiting the EMPO’s ability to fully utilize our PPM solutions, so we reached out to CA Services.
