VMware VCF VCI Program

Only VCF Authorized Learning Partners and VCF VCIs may deliver VMware VCF training.

New VCF VCI Qualifications:

- VCF Authorized Learning Partners nominate a VCF VCI candidate
- Candidates apply and receive confirmation from VMware
- Candidates attend the current version of VMware vSphere: Install, Configure, Manage
- Candidates take and pass the VCP: DCV exam with a score of 350 or higher
- Candidates request admission and participate in an ICW
- Successful candidates are informed of course completion in writing and move on towards onboarding and teach requirements

The VMware Instructor Certification Workshop (ICW) is the final step in the VCF VMware Certified Instructor (VCI) new candidate qualification process. The ICW is designed to test a candidate's technical knowledge of the product, course contents, and presentation style, including but not limited to effective question handling, whiteboard skills, and instruction variance for different learning styles.

VMware ICW Invitation:

The workshop is only accessible by invite only. The VCF VCI Program will only grant an invitation to participate in a ICW if the candidate, who is actively associated with a VCF Authorized Learning Partner, has met all of the prior new candidate requirements, which can be found [here](#). Once invited to participate in an ICW, each candidate will receive detailed information on what to expect and how to prepare.

Scheduling and Delivery:

The ICW is offered globally per a set schedule. Each ICW is hosted by two senior instructors who will assess your performance throughout the five-day workshop. This process allows VCF VCI candidates to understand the technical detail and scope that is expected from VMware.

Course Completion:

Candidates who successfully pass the ICW will be informed in writing and welcomed into the VCF VCI program.
