# Exam Details (Last Updated: 08/15/2025)

The VMware Cloud Foundation 9.0 Support (2V0-18.25) exam, which leads to VMware Certified Professional - VMware vSphere® Foundation Certification (VCP-VVF Support), is a 60-item exam in English with a passing score of 300 using a scaled method. Candidates are given an appointment time of 135 minutes, which includes adequate time to complete the exam for non- native English speakers.

# Minimally Qualified Candidate

The candidate can apply standard troubleshooting techniques and methodologies to issues identified during the deployment, and running, of a VMware vSphere Foundation (VVF) 9.0. The candidate must possess a high level understanding of a VMware vSphere Foundation 9.0 solution, including the features, functions, components and architecture models. The VMware vSphere Foundation 9.0 components include VCF Operations, vCenter, VMware ESX, VMware vSAN, and VMware Operations for logs.

The candidate will have a minimum of 1 year experience supporting and troubleshooting VMware vSphere Foundation components, either in isolation or as part of a VMware vSphere Foundation (VVF) Deployment/Instance. In addition, the candidate will have at least 2 years of overall IT experience. When called upon, the candidate may occasionally need to research various advanced VVF-related support topics or troubleshooting tasks, and may even request assistance from a colleague or Broadcom support. The candidate possesses most of the knowledge shown in the exam sections (blueprint).

- > Given a scenario, generate a log bundle and upload via log assist.
- > Given a scenario, create a dashboard/report/alert to troubleshoot an issue

- > Given a scenario, troubleshoot an issue with the configuration of VCF Operations Orchestrator
